Inaugurated in February 2000, this award honors recipients for their contributions to the gemological field and their work to establish and maintain high professional standards. Bonanno award recipients are recognized and presented with a specially commissioned bronze plaque and medallion, together with a check for \$2,000 during the Gala Awards Ceremony & Dinner following the AGA Conference in Tucson, AZ.

Past recipients include leading research gemologists from world-renowned laboratories, educators, market analysts, and innovators of equipment and technology that have positively impacted the world of gemology.

Nominations are open to the global gemological community. AGA membership is not required for nominations or nominees. A nomination should be for an individual candidate and not a team.
